

This collaborative project aims to create a sustainable green space using the innovative Miyawaki method, which promotes the growth of dense, native forests that help combat climate change and enhance biodiversity.

What is Miyawaki?

The Miyawaki method, developed by Japanese botanist Dr. Akira Miyawaki, involves planting native species to create fast-growing, high-biodiversity forests. These forests help reduce CO2, improve air quality, and restore ecological balance in urban spaces.

Date: 23 February 2025



A Call to Action for Peace and Understanding



Let's use this moment not just to celebrate, but to take action – through both small and large gestures – to continue our pursuit of peace, goodwill, and understanding among all people.








