Rotary Club of Surat Tapi, Swami Vivekananda Netra Mandir Surat, D S PatelCharitable Trust Sachin and AtoZ Multispeciality hospitl Sachin organized free eye checkup camp and free cataract surgery and free medical checkup camp at AtoZ Hospital in which 103 persons were examined, including 50 children of Saraswati Oriya School Kanakpur. 


