Observing World Suicide Prevention Day | A Powerful Online Session by Rotary

On September 10, 2025, Rotary Club of Surat Tapi and Rotary Club of Surat West jointly organized a meaningful online awareness session to mark World Suicide Prevention Day — a day that reminds us of the urgent need to promote hope, empathy, and mental well-being.

The event was steered with great dedication by

We were honored by the gracious presence of our District Governor Rtn. Amardeepsingh Bunet, respected PDGs including Devendraji and Santosh Pradhanji, along with many District Officers, Club Presidents, Secretaries, and members from neighboring districts – truly reflecting the Rotary spirit of "Service Above Self."

The highlight of the event was a powerful session by the esteemed Dr. Abha Bang Soni, Consultant Psychiatrist and Director at ASSSAN Hospital, titled "How You Can Save a Life."

Dr. Abha delivered impactful insights on suicide prevention, sharing startling data — one suicide every 40 seconds, and 20 times more people experience suicidal thoughts. She emphasized how timely awareness, compassion, and open conversations can help save lives.

The interactive Q&A session allowed participants to gain deeper understanding and clarify important aspects of mental health and suicide prevention.

Dr. Abha also shared critical helpline numbers and resources for those seeking help—a reminder that no one needs to suffer in silence.


