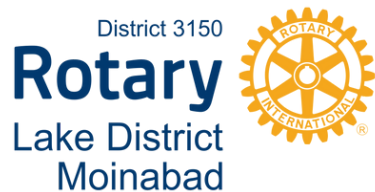

WORLD MENTAL HEALTH DAY - 10 OCT 2025

ENT Screening Camps - 16th October 2025

Rotary Club of Lake District Moinabad, in association with MAA E.N.T. Hospitals and MAA Research Foundation, conducted a Free E.N.T., Speech, and Hearing Screening Camp on 16th October 2025 at Zilla Parishad High School and Primary School, Raikode, Sangareddy District.

More than 600 children were screened for ear, nose, throat, speech, and hearing concerns, with a focus on identifying those needing early intervention and specialized care. The project was initiated and personally visited by Rtn. Sunita on behalf of RCLD, reflecting the club's dedication to promoting child health and preventive medical awareness in rural communities.



ENT Screening Camp at Government Schools, Osman Nagar -22nd October 2025
