
#### World Heart Day - Awareness Session



This initiative truly reflected RCLD's commitment to community health awareness and education, reinforcing the message that prevention is always better than cure.








# SUCIDE PREVENTION AWARENESS - 20 Sept 2025

On 20th September 2025, Rotary Club of Lake District, Moinabad, hosted an impactful session under its Manogna - Mental Health Awareness Program at the First Floor Auditorium, MAA Hospitals. The session focused on Suicide Prevention Awareness and was led by noted Clinical Psychologist Ms. Bona Colaco.

With great depth and empathy, Ms. Colaco addressed the rising mental health concerns among youth, shared insights on early warning signs, and emphasized the importance of open conversations and timely support systems. About 75 participants, including students, nurses, junior doctors, and parents, attended the session. The talk not only educated but also sparked meaningful conversations on how stigma and silence often prevent timely help, leaving the audience with much to reflect upon.














#### **BATHUKAMMA CELEBRATIONS**




#### TEACHERS DAY FELICITAION - 05 SEPT 2025

Dear Rotarians,


