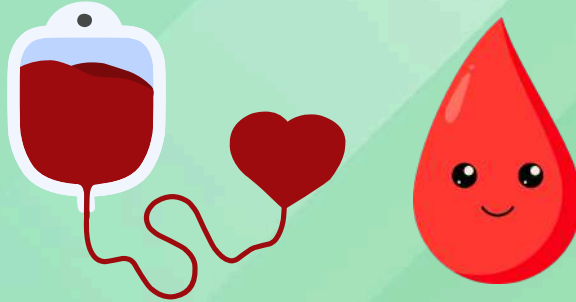
TRF contributors were acknowledged, and Rtn. Mehul Gor shared insights on membership growth. The meeting concluded with announcements and fellowship.

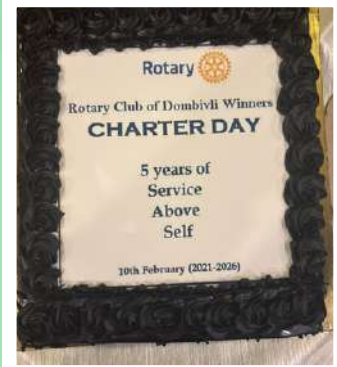
# Regular Meeting
