MAA – Kit Distribution to Underprivileged Widow Mother

Project Date : 1st Dec 2024

This is a mother care project of RC of Calcutta North East, where essential items are donated to 100+ widows. In the 9th edition of this flagship project of RC of Calcutta North East, RCCP was a co-host and sponsored 4 kits of 2,500 each. The project that cost RCCP Rs 10,000, benefitted 10 women and took approximately 10 hours, was led by Rtn Soumya Priya Mukherjee.

APARAJITA- Cervical Cancer Vaccination for Batighar Pathshala girls

Project Date: 23rd December 2024

When the District announced the launch of Aparajita, an initiative to supply cervical cancer vaccination to women and girls, RCCP decided to take the programme to 28 girl students of Batighar Pathshala which is an informal school for children residing in the high- risk red- light area of Kalighat. RCCP has been associated with Batighar Pathshala through the NGO Jadavpur Bondhu Collective Welfare Society for the last 5 years. The beneficiaries who hail from very impoverished backgrounds, lack awareness of the risks inherent in the environment they are forced to live in.

Cervavac Vaccine will be procured from Serum Institute @Rs 2560 for 2 doses and @Rs 1440 for 1 dose. LB Care, the logistic partner of Serum Institute, would provide the vaccination service. RCCP has received EIRWT grant for 50% of the vaccine cost from District 3291.

The first dose was given on 23rd December 2024, the second will be given on 23rd February 2025 and the third on 23rd June 2025.

The project that will cost Rs 1,10,000 approx, benefit 28 girls, and take about 50 hours, is led by Rtn Nabanita Khan. She will be assisted by Rtn Sujoy Majumdar, Rtn Sachindra Rao and Rtn Soumya Priya Mukherjee.
