SUN'S CYBER CORNER - By Sunil Sadasivan (Cyber Security Expert & Resource Person)

Hack Vs Fake:

Recently, I have received numerous complaints, predominantly from female victims, claiming that their Facebook accounts have been compromised. Before proceeding to file a Cyber Complaint regarding Facebook Hacking, it is essential to clarify certain aspects. We must ascertain whether our profile has indeed been hacked or if a fake profile has been created by malicious individuals.

Hacking implies that we are unable to access our Facebook account, observe inappropriate posts

appearing on our timeline, and notice unfamiliar individuals being added to our friend list. Additionally, attempts to log in may result in incorrect credential messages. These indicators suggest that our account has been compromised, and control has been seized by unauthorized users.

On the other hand, a Fake Account refers to a situation where individuals create an account using our name, photo, and personal details. These impostors may send friend requests to our contacts, successfully deceiving them into believing they are interacting with us due to the use of our likeness and information. The first and most crucial step is to report this to Facebook. When doing so, it is vital to clearly communicate whether our account has been hacked or if a fake profile has been established.

Periodically conducting a Google search in our name is a good idea, in identifying any profiles or accounts that may have been created in our name. It is possible to discover a profile associated with our identity, even if we are not active on Facebook or X (formerly Twitter), which poses a significant threat.
