EMPOWERIMG YOUTHS, ENRICHING LIVES RCD WEST - TSSC SKILL DEVELOPEPMENT PROGRAM







The Rotary Club of Delhi West launched the Rotary TSSC Skill Development Program in RY 2022-23 under DG Rtn. Ashok Kantoor's leadership, spearheaded by PP Rtn Rakesh Talwar, is aligned with Rotary International's Global Skilling Initiatives. The project is funded through contributions from members, CSR, and Global Grants.

In partnership with the **Telecom Sector Skill Council (TSSC)**, the program targets unemployed students (12th pass, undergraduates, and graduates) recommended by Rotarians of District 3011. Training is free, with assured placements in **Delhi NCR (Gurgaon, Faridabad, Haryana)**.

Key Activities

- 1. Online & offline training, including OJT and internships
- 2. Candidate assessment & certification
- 3. Placement assistance

Courses Offered

- 1. In-Store Promoter
- 2. Field Sales Executive
- 3. Telecom Customer Care Executive
- 4. Handheld Device Technician
- 5. Optical Fibre Technician
- 6.5G Network Project Engineer
- 7. Telecom Technician (IoT Systems)

Roles & Responsibilities

Rotary – Funding, space/infrastructure, and mobilization of candidates.

TSSC – Mobilization, training, assessment, certification, and placement (80% offers with min. 50% joining).

Unique Approach

Unlike many programs that stop at training, RCDW ensures **employment is integral**. Success is measured by job placement, verified through appointment letters, salary slips, and follow-up.

Objectives

- Provide industry-relevant skills to needy youth
- Ensure certification with assured jobs
- Create a replicable skilling model linking training, certification, and employment

Process Flow

- Training partner selection & student mobilization
- Employer mandate before course start
- 390–480 hours of classroom/online training
- On-the-job training with industry partners
- Certification & 100% placement with monitoring

Outcomes

- 364 students trained & employed
- 200 students under training (to finish by Sept 30)
- 100% placement achieved

Impact

- Sustainable livelihoods for underprivileged youth
- Industry-aligned employability
- Transparent, accountable, replicable skilling model
