## Community Service Project: Enhancing Public Health through Pesticide Distribution



The Rotary e-Club of Mysuru Center, in collaboration with the International Fellowship of Motorcycling Rotarians (IFMR) Mysore Subchapter, embarked on a vital community service initiative. The project aimed to address the rising cases of Dengue fever and flu in the region, particularly during the monsoon season. By providing pesticide spray systems and equipment to the workers of Mysuru City Corporation (MCC) in ward no. 58, the project sought to significantly impact public health and sanitation.

The project, titled “Distribution of Pesticide Spray Systems and Equipment,” took place on 7th July 2024. Key project leaders included Past President & ZL Rtn PHF Shadakshari Swami (Project Chairman) and Rtn. Vijai Bopanna (President for 2024-25). Other essential team members included Past President Rtn PHF Thejesh Kumar, Honorary Secretary Rtn. Tejaswini Alva, Rtn. PHF Subramanya. N, Rtn. Bharath, and the spouses and children of Rotarians.

The project focused on the distribution of pesticide spray systems and related equipment. These tools would empower MCC workers to conduct targeted pest control measures in public spaces, residential areas, and other locations within ward no. 58.

The project directly benefited more than 1200 residents of Ramakrishna Nagar ward no. 58. By reducing the mosquito population and preventing the breeding of disease-carrying insects, we aimed to safeguard the health and well-being of the local community.

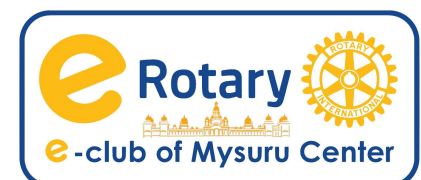


The distribution took place in Mysuru Ramakrishna Nagar ward no. 58.
