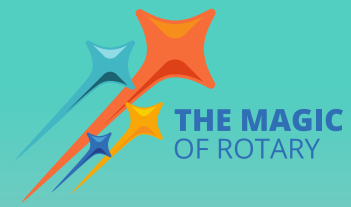
As the great poet Rabindranath Tagore once said, "I slept and dreamt that life was joy. I awoke and saw that life was service. I acted and behold, service was joy."

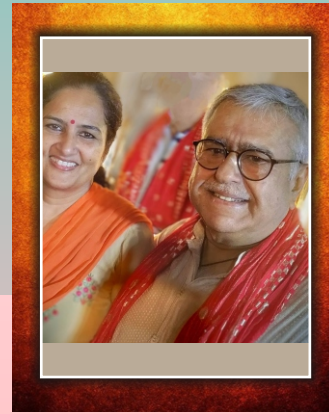
As Mahatma Gandhi so eloquently put it, "The best way to find yourself is to lose yourself in the service of others."
