

## Empowering Women through Annapurna Day Initiative

Rotary Club of Navi Mumbai Flamingo City Distributes Ration Kits on Annapurna Day

On Annapurna Day, the Rotary Club of Navi Mumbai Flamingo City distributed 51 dry ration kits to the hardworking lady workers of the NRI Complex. This initiative aimed to support single-earning women with essential food supplies sufficient for 15 days.

Each kit included rice, wheat flour, pulses, salt, sugar, tea, desi ghee, cooking oil, and dry spices. The distribution event took place at a central location in the NRI Complex for easy access.

Club members, dressed in bright yellow shirts, actively participated, symbolizing hope and positivity. The smiles on the beneficiaries' faces reflected the success of the initiative and the club's commitment to making a difference.

#### **Nourishing Minds and Bodies**

#### Rotary's Roti Machine Transforms Karjat Tribal School

The Rotary Club of Navi Mumbai Flamingo City (RCNMFC) recently made a significant impact at a tribal school in Karjat through our Project Roti Making Machine. This initiative aimed to address a pressing issue at the boarding cum day scholar school, which accommodates over 650 students from underprivileged tribal communities.

Despite the government's provision of free midday meals, the school faced a major challenge in preparing sufficient food due to a shortage of kitchen staff. With only six staff members, it was nearly impossible to prepare the 2,400+ chapatis needed within the limited lunch break time. Consequently, the students often had to settle for meals consisting solely of rice, dal, and curry.

Our solution was to donate a state-of-the-art roti making machine capable of producing 600 chapatis per hour. This machine has revolutionized meal preparation at the school, enabling the staff to provide a full, nutritious meal that includes chapatis. The impact of this contribution was immediately evident in the gratitude expressed by the school community.

On a rainy Sunday, over 60 students, along with the Headmaster, Principal, and members of another NGO, Saath Saath, gathered to thank the RCNMFC team. Their heartfelt appreciation and the overwhelming sense of gratitude they showed were truly touching. It was a powerful reminder of the good work being done by our club and the difference we can make in the lives of these children.

As Rotarians, witnessing the positive change brought about by our efforts reaffirms our commitment to service above self. The smiles and gratitude of the students and staff at the Karjat school are a testament to the impact of our collective generosity and dedication. This project has not only provided a practical solution to a significant problem but also strengthened the bonds between our club and the community we serve.



#### **Rotary Club Drives Lifesaving Blood Donation**
