Now we need 2 wooden cupboards for our science laboratory as our 60 years old cupboards broke down and had to be given away due to termite infestation.


We will be very happy to receive donation of the IKEA Cupboards (BRIMNES glass -door cabinet – white, 80X190cm)

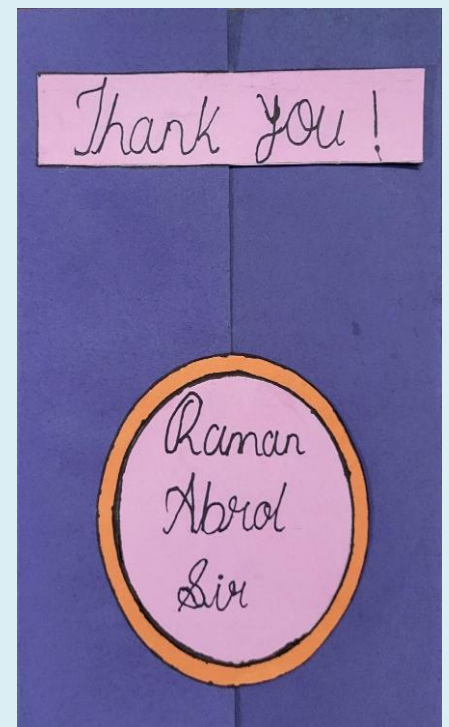
We assure you it will be put to great use, and we would be highly grateful and obliged for the same.
