SEVEN AREAS OF FOCUS

Rotary operates basically in the following Seven Areas of Focus

- PEACE BUILDING & CONFLICT PREVENTION
- DISEASE PREVENTION AND TREATMENT
- WATER, SANITATION, AND HYGIENE
- MATERNAL AND CHILD HEALTH
- BASIC EDUCATION AND LITERACY
- COMMUNITY ECNOMIC DEVELOPMENT
- ENVIRONMENT

Our club with experienced members supported by the youth undertakes study of the neighbourhood and the surrounding communities to identify the needs of the people who are unserved or underserved. Formulate a project to address specific needs of the people around, plan the project requirements such as availability of experts / skilled people, material required, measures needed for sustainability of the projects etc. We hold detailed discussion with the community/school/ organisation and appraise them of the benefits, reach and impact of such project. If needed, we partner with other community groups/organizations (like RCCs, NGOs, Interact club or Rotaract Club). We plan and arrange the finances to execute the project by sourcing the funds from Rotary Foundation, CSR funds, Individual donations and contributions from members of our club and / or fellow Rotary clubs.

DISEASE PREVENTION & TREATMENT

Rotary supports activities that reduce causes and effects of disease. Projects strengthen the health care system by improving access to and expanding medical services, providing medical equipment, or training health care personnel. Some of the activities include a) disease testing through screen & health camps, b) supplying medical equipment to healthcare facilities, c) providing equipment to offer health care services in remote rural areas, d) providing surveillance systems to track and monitor the diagnosis of disease and treatment of disease, e) addressing environmental hazards related to infection and disease containment.

Our club has conducted free cancer screening camps in semi-urban and rural areas. It has organized multispeciality medical camps and arranged surgeries in the hospitals. Eye ware was donated to the people with vision deficiency. Arranged free cataract surgeries for rural people Club also provided Physio therapy equipment to the students with physical and developmental disabilities.
