

April is Maternal and Child Health Month

Zone-3



Rotary International's new monthly theme for April is Maternal and Child Health! Every day mothers risk their lives giving birth and millions of children die each year from treatable, preventable causes. At least 7 million children under the age of five die each year due to malnutrition, and poor health care, inadequate sanitation. To help reduce this rate, Rotary provides immunizations and antibiotics to babies, improves access to essential medical services, and supports trained

health care providers for mothers and their children.

Rotary's projects ensure sustainability by empowering the local community to take ownership of health care training programs. Maternal and Child Health Care is also recognized as one of Rotary's Six Areas of Focus.

Mobile prenatal clinics

Haiti has the highest maternal and infant mortality rate of any country in the western hemisphere. Rotary provided a fully equipped medical Jeep to volunteers and midwives to reach mothers and children in remote areas.

Cancer screening

Rotarians provided a mobile cancer screening unit and awareness trainings around Chennai, India, where there is a high mortality rate of women with breast and cervical cancer due to late diagnosis.

Preventing injuries and deaths

Rotary members launched a \$3 million, five-year pilot to save lives of mothers and children during home deliveries in Nigeria. Since 2005, they've also repaired 1,500 obstetric fistulas — 500 more than their initial goal — restoring dignity and hope to vulnerable mothers.

On March 4, 2025, the Rotary Club of Phoenix sponsored an important team to our district as the Interact Club of Phoenix. The team interact is made up of all members of an underprivileged Government HR Sec school, maniyanoor, in a rural area, which is typically far away from the town.

The club is the first of its kind in the district, and it was started by 20 students from the underprivileged category. Phoenix's president and the Interact chair will serve as the club's direct leaders, supporting the students' society as well as their school.

As a token effort, they themselves donated the school a sanitary napkin vending machine, which will help the roughly 600 female pupils in the school. The project was completed on the same day that the school received the Interact charter presentation from the sponsored Club RC Phoenix. When napkins are needed, the machine will be replenished; the sponsored club, RC Phoenix, will do this once every 15 days. Two machines will be added and stored in a secure area of the school grounds after the concept is refined; this could also benefit the general public.


