The main objective of this project is to create an inclusive and supportive education system in Goa, where every child, regardless of their abilities or background, has an access to quality education and can reach their full potential.

- Training teachers across Goa to empower them for inclusive education under National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 and Vocational training to teachers to enable skill development of special and underprivileged children to make them an asset to the society.
- We plan to transform Vidya
 Vardhini Education Society's
 school for special Children located
 in Usgao, Goa into a state-of-the art facility that provides services to
 students with special needs.
 Imparting vocational training to
 educators of the school, will
 empower the children with special
 needs, with different skills tailored
 to their unique capacities. To make
 them self-reliant and confident by
 providing a great support system.
- We also intend to upgrade the infrastructure of two schools in Mormugao taluka, Goa for underprivileged children includinh modernization of classrooms/Library, incorporating innovative technology and comfortable tables and seats. We will also organize workshops to improve the teaching skills on regular basis even after the grant is completed.



Rotary District 3170 Synergy Passport was chartered on 15th August 2022 with 20 new members supported by 10 experienced Rotarians.

Our Club has done many smaller and meaningful projects in the last few years, and are now planning our first global grant with a total budget of ~US\$ 49,500.
