February 2024 Message of RI President 2023-24

I am enthused and encouraged by your embrace of mental health initiatives throughout the Rotary world. More than 1,000 of you have responded so far to an ongoing survey by the Rotary Action Group on Mental Health Initiatives, offering your feedback on what Rotary can do to improve the personal well-being of members.

The top suggestions are illuminating. Rotary members are asking for more fellowship, camaraderie, conversation, cohesiveness, and connection. They also want more recognition, validation, and integration. They are seeking more service opportunities. Message of Jeetender Gupta, D G, District 3011

Dear Hope Creators,
For the first time, RID 3011 has crossed and maintained the 5000 member mark this year, despite various challenges. 12 new clubs have been chartered across the district - Delhi (4), Faridabad (2), Gurgaon (1), Narnaul (1), Palwal (1), Rohtak (3). Our women membership ratio is one of the highest in the world at 29.7%. Our biggest membership challenge comes from the clubs which have so far registered zero growth or negative growth. We need to achieve net one member growth atleast for each club. We have touched some new Milestones when it comes to TRF (The Rotary Foundation) contribution. An unprecedented 1500 members (30% of total membership) have donated some or the other amount however big or small, to TRF. We are ready with District Grant application on behalf of 50+ Clubs. The delay in processing is on account of non-closure of past District Grant. The needful should be done shortly. We can expect release of funds in next couple of weeks.

I take this opportunity to invite each of you to participate in the upcoming events as a run up to District Conference (9th-10th March 2023) through Rotary Idol (Singing Competition), Rotary Premier League (Cricket), District Golf, TRF Fund Raiser and ultimately the main Conference Yugantar. Let us do our best to "Create Hope in the World" while gearing up to celebrate "The Magic of Rotary". (Source : GML of January 2024)

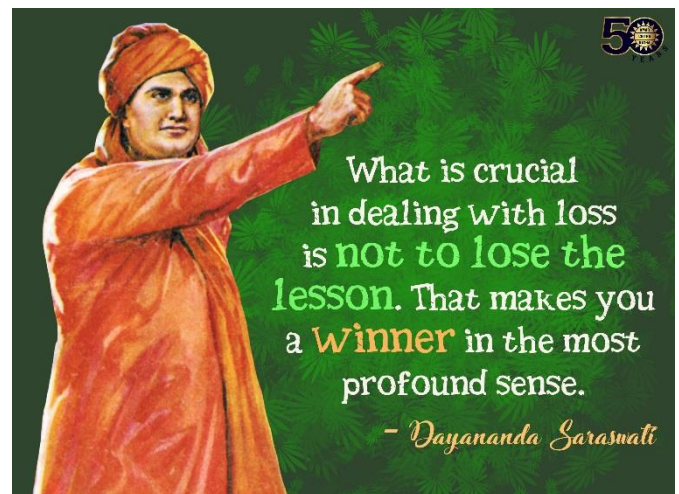
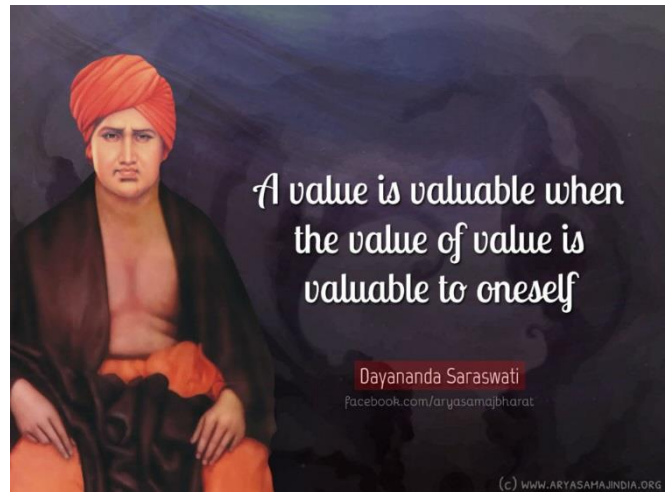

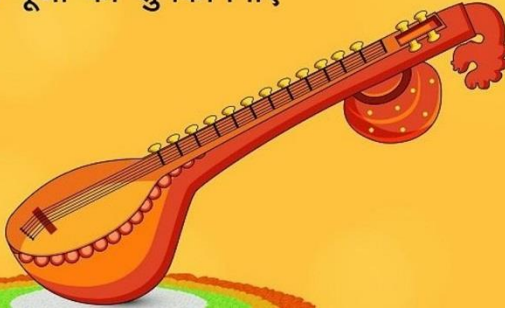

ROTARY HISTORY - The Paul Harris Fellow recognition acknowledges individuals who contribute, or who have contributions made in their name, of \$1,000 to **The Rotary Foundation**.

Rotary established the **recognition** in 1957 to encourage and show appreciation for substantial contributions to what was then the Foundation's only program, Rotary Foundation Fellowships for Advanced Study, the precursor to Ambassadorial Scholarships.

Many other notable figures have been named Paul Harris Fellows, including U.S. President Jimmy Carter, Russian President Boris Yeltsin, U.S. astronaut James Lovell, UN Secretary-General Javier Perez de Cuellar, and polio vaccine developer Jonas Salk.

The number of Paul Harris Fellows reached the 1 million mark in 2006.

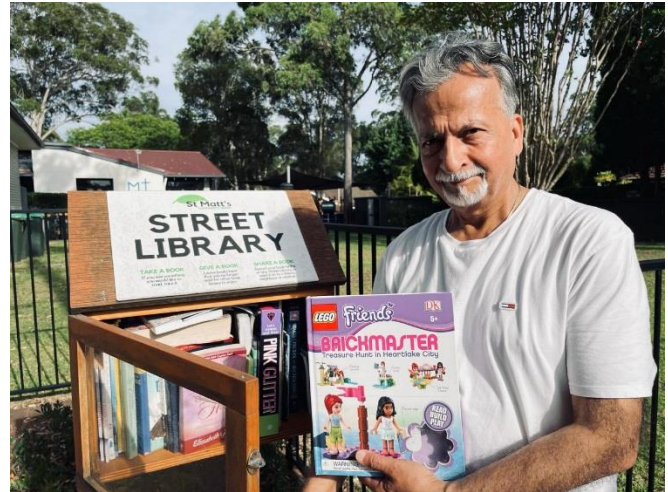
