A Portrait of Leadership: Stephanie A. Urchick

Stephanie A. Urchick's journey with Rotary is a tapestry of dedication and impact. As an RI director and Rotary Foundation trustee, she has held pivotal roles such as training leader, regional Rotary Foundation coordinator, and RI president's representative. Her influence extends to three sessions of the Council on Legislation as a representative and member-at-large.

Urchick has chaired the Strategic Planning Committee and The Rotary Foundation's Centennial Celebration Committee. Her contributions span numerous Rotary committees, including the Election Review Committee and Operational Review Committee.

Since joining Rotary in 1991, Urchick has immersed herself in international service. She participated in National Immunization Days in India and Nigeria and collaborated with clubs in Vietnam to build a primary school. Her efforts in the Dominican Republic involved installing water filters. Proficient in several Slavic languages, Urchick has mentored new Rotary members in Ukraine and secured a Rotary Foundation grant for mammography equipment and a biopsy unit for a hospital in Poland. Recognized by the Rotary Club of Krakow for her role in revitalizing Rotary in post-Communist Poland, she has also facilitated partnerships between U.S. clubs and those in Albania, Kosovo, and Ukraine.

Professionally, Urchick's background spans higher education, consulting, and entertainment. She holds a doctorate in Leadership Studies from Indiana University of Pennsylvania and has been lauded by The Rotary Foundation and various community and international organizations.

Urchick calls on members to champion Rotary's Action Plan to strengthen clubs, balance continuity and change, and promote peace. She highlights the critical mission of eradicating polio, encouraging members to join or start PolioPlus Societies and contribute to ending the disease. Urchick is set to lead the 2025 Rotary Presidential Peace Conference in Istanbul, Turkey, with the theme "Healing in a Divided World" from February 20-22, 2025.

Rotary is dedicated to weaving diversity, equity, and inclusion (DEI) into the fabric of everything we do.

Our commitment is not just a statement but a living principle upheld by our Board of Directors and DEI Advisory Council. Recently, we fortified our DEI statement, originally embraced in 2019:
