- 5. Street Adoption: Promoting beautification, waste management, road safety, and street cleaning.
- 6. Project Restore Reviving Rotary's Legacy: Reinvigorating past club projects that are currently in bad condition or on hold. This includes efforts like PolioPlus Revamp, providing dictionaries/books for schools, vocational training, and health camps. Each club president is encouraged to find the status of projects done by their club in the past 10 years.
- 7. Be International: Encouraging participation in Rotary Fellowships and Rotary Action Groups for global networking, professional growth, and cultural exchange.
- 8. Youth Mentoring: Offering mentorship, self-confidence building, skill development, career quidance, and mental health support.
- 9. Paediatric Heart Surgeries: Providing life-saving medical interventions for children and reducing the financial burden on families.

#### 10. End Thalassemia:

Focusing on awareness talks, blood check-ups (targeting 10,000 in 2025-26), and access to specialized education and therapies.

By embracing these "TITEN" initiatives, our clubs will benefit from alignment with District Goals, increased visibility and recognition, reward points for District and RI citations, access to District Resources, and enhanced networking opportunities.

Let's unite our passion and dedication to make "Unite for Good" a powerful reality in District 3142, creating lasting positive change together.
