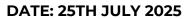

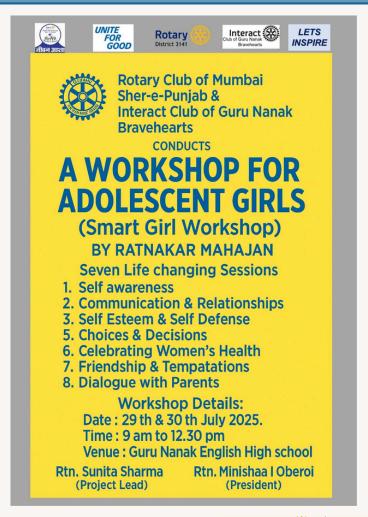

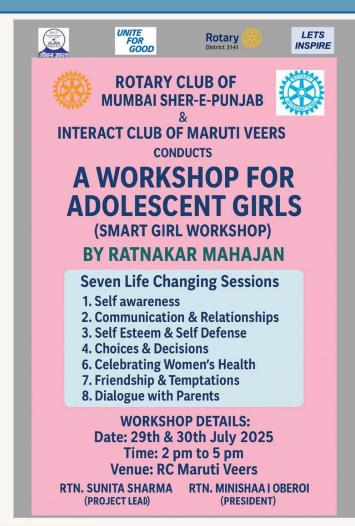

Method:

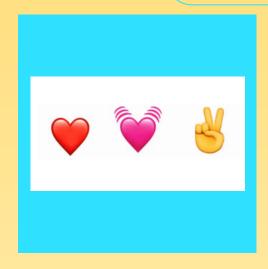

Garnish with grated cheese n serve n enjoy

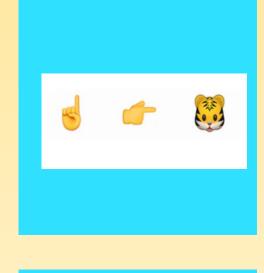
