

### Flavours of Fellowship

### Kosambari

### Ingredients

- 1. Moong daal 1 handful (one karchi)
- 2. Cucumber 2 small
- 3. Lemon 1
- 4. Salt as per taste
- 5. Pepper as per taste
- 6. Green coriander little
- 7. Urad daal one pinch ( around 20 seeds)
- 8. Mustard one pinch ( around 20 seeds)
- 9. Curry leaves 10 leaves
- 10. Red chilli 2 small
- 11. Sunflower oil 2 teaspoons





Method

- 1. Wash the moong daal well and soak it in water for 3 to 4 hours
- 2. The soaked daal water needs to be drained and kept dry in a bowl.
- 3. Cut Cucumber (without seeds) into small equal pieces. Add them on the daal.
- 4. Cut coriander and add them too.
- 5. Add salt, pepper and lemon as per the taste.
- 6. Add the Tadka ( as mentioned below)
- 7. Mix them well
- 8. Serve

Flower Petals: One flower in the right image has an extra petal compared to its counterpart on the left.
