

Donating Money to Dilip Soni to help face his immediate financial crisis

Two calamities struck Dilip Soni around the same time.

- 1. His business of hand stitched clothes folded up due to the introduction of latest automatic machines. So he is unable to pay even the interest of 1% per month on the Rs. 2 lakhs he had borrowed. He has to pay interest for 3 months at a time, so Rs. 6,000.
- 2. Next, his landlord is selling the flat and is forcing him to vacate (just got an extention of 4 months now). He does not have money to pay the accumulated rent.
- 3. He is now supporting his wife who makes theplas. If he takes some other job even this business will collapse, so he prefers to try and continue to support his wife's business which could grow.
- 4. The problem is he has two small children and is even unable to pay for their daily school requirements.
- 5. When I contacted him for our music program he was refusing to respond. I learnt he was in a state of deep depression and contemplating suicide. So I immediately paid him Rs. 50,000, I also contributed another Rs. 10,000 during the music program for him. He is now out of depression but still sees nothing in sight how to support his family and pay his debt of Rs. 2 lakhs plus interest....also has to vacate his rented flat (will come on the road).

Even with some temporary relief and if his wife's business grows, he may succeed in pulling out of this situation, but temporary support is a must. He is a genuine case and a very decent person who I request all to support by chipping in whatever we can afford


