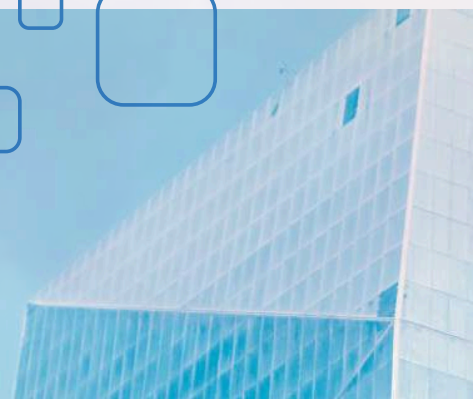
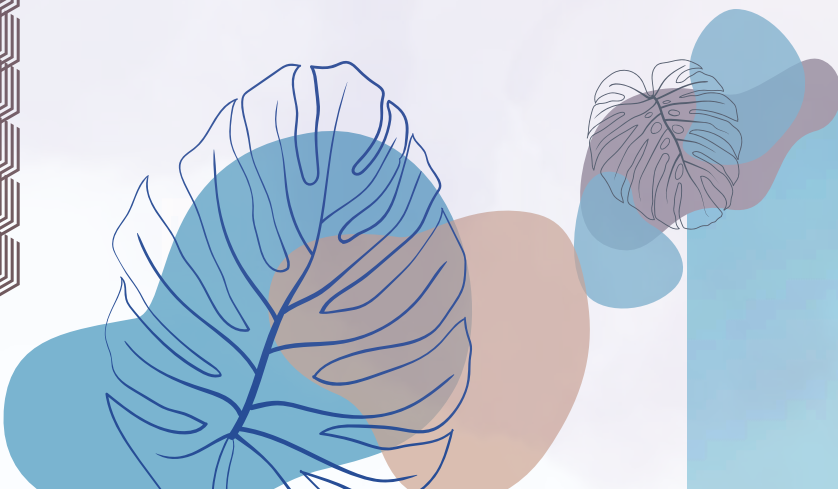

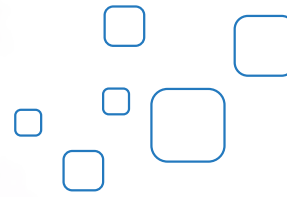

We extend our gratitude to DG Dinesh Mehta, the District TRF Team, and the host club for this enriching experience that strengthened our resolve to serve.

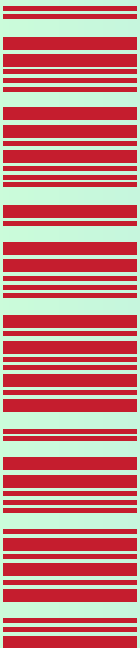

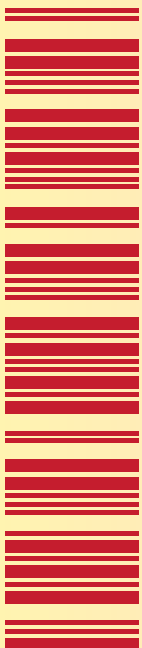
