# Message from Secretary



The Second Quarter edition of our club magazine highlights the vibrant service journey of the “Rotary Club of Aspiring Agartala” during October, November, and December 2025. These months reflected our unwavering commitment to Rotary’s avenues of service, with impactful projects in polio eradication, health, community welfare, and fellowship across Tripura.

Key projects and activities, including their places, were:

-October 2025(Economic and Community Development Month): Active participation in the End Polio Now campaign through contributions to the PolioPlus fund to support global eradication efforts. Activities were primarily based in Agartala and surrounding areas, reinforcing our ongoing commitment to a polio-free world.

- November 2025 (Vocational Service and Rotary Foundation Month):

- Observance of National Immunisation Day on 21st November, administering Pulse Polio vaccines as part of the nationwide campaign at Tulsibati School (MTB School), Agartala, in collaboration with government officials, dignitaries from the Health and Family Welfare Department, and National Health Mission Tripura.

Celebration of the club's 1st Charter Night on 21st November with a grand fellowship event in Agartala, marking a milestone and inspiring renewed service commitments among members.

- December 2025 (Disease Prevention and Treatment Month):

- Support for and association with the Limb “Donation Camp” starting mid-December, e.g., from 15th December onward, focused on prosthetic limb fittings and mobility restoration, primarily in the Agartala region (in collaboration with partners like medical colleges and foundations).

- A mega health camp providing essential medical services at “Mohanpur” (approximately 22 km from Agartala).

Amid these meaningful projects, a standout act of profound compassion was Rtn. Sanjiban Datta (Foundation Chair) formalizing his Body donation pledge after demise facilitated in the presence of Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tripura, Prof. (Dr.) Manik Saha in Agartala. This promotes the gift of knowledge for medical education, research, and training—truly a novel and ultimate form of service beyond life.

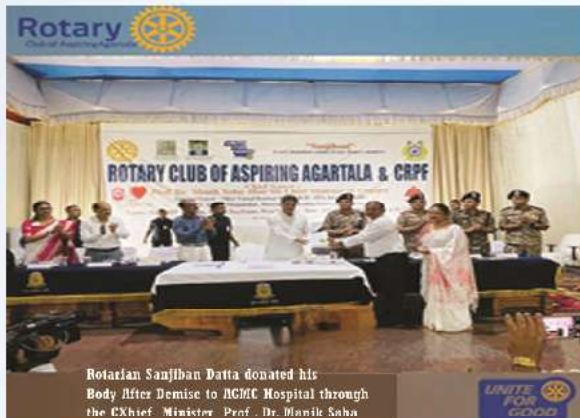

**Rotary TEN Dollar Month: Empowering Polio Eradication in District 3240**



In October 2025, Rotary District 3240, spanning Northeast India and Bengal, ignited the TEN Dollar Month campaign to honour World Polio Day on October 24. This initiative challenged every Rotary club member to donate at least \$10 to the Polio Fund, fostering collective action toward a polio-free world. The Rotary Club of Agartala Aspiring exemplified this spirit, achieving 100% member participation and earning designation as the 9th TEN Dollar Club in District - 3240. Their commitment amplified Rotary's global PolioPlus efforts, matching contributions from partners like the Gates Foundation to triple impact.

Club celebrated 24th October, 2025, World Polio Day with a grand awareness rally, drawing enthusiastic participation from 13th Battalion Tripura NCC Cadets (MBB College Unit) alongside dedicated Rotary members.

The event was flagged off at 7:30 am from Rabindra Satabarshiki Bhawan by Honourable IGP Tripura Police Shri Krishnendu Chakraborty.

Apart from that, on that very day, the Rotary Club of Aspiring Agartala installed four high-visibility flex banners at strategic City Junctions—Agartala Government College (GB Hospital), Indira Gandhi Memorial Hospital (IGM), Maharaj Ganj Bazar (Gol Bazar- Main Market Place of Tripura), Central Road Extn (Key Market Place). Each 7x5 ft banner boldly displayed “Two Drops of Life Shield – End Polio Now”, Rotary logo, Club name, and message for vaccination.



Designed in vibrant colours, they urged parents to vaccinate children under 5, daily commuters saw the message, sparking conversations. Local media covered the initiative, praising Rotary’s leadership since 1988.

This Polio Plus Public Image Project reinforced Rotary’s promise of a polio-free world while showcasing the club’s proactive community role.

Awareness cum Demonstration training program on "BAMBOO JEWELLERY MAKING" At NB INSTITUTE FOR RURAL TECHNOLOGY - "ARKANEER"

This hands-on initiative aims to empower rural artisans and entrepreneurs by imparting skill-based training in bamboo jewellery making—a sustainable, eco-friendly, and income-generating craft. Participants learned design techniques, material processing, finishing, and market linkages to promote self-reliance and community development. The programme aligns with Rotary's focus on economic empowerment and sustainable livelihoods, fostering innovation and entrepreneurship at the grassroots level. The Rotary Club of Aspiring Agartala extended its heartfelt appreciation to all stakeholders for their unwavering commitment to community upliftment. Among the 19 dedicated Women trainees, the Club graciously presented Participation Certificates, recognizing their active involvement and enthusiasm in mastering this transformative skill.



Sanjivani - cataract screening camp

The Rotary Club of Aspiring Agartala, in collaboration with Tripura Medical College and NEEPCO's , organized a cataract screening camp. This initiative offers total 150 free cataract surgeries, including high-quality intraocular lenses to enhance healthcare accessibility.

Residents from 2nd BN TSR Camp and also underserved areas of Radha Kishore Pur-Budhjung Nagar , underwent examinations by expert ophthalmologists. The camp saw enthusiastic participation, highlighting the critical need for eye care outreach. By restoring vision, this effort brings hope and improves quality of life for under-privileged families, commitment to social welfare and Rotary's Moto " Service Above Self"
