#### Social Impact

Since its inception in May, the Next Gen Centre in Chetpet has been a beacon of hope for the local community. Partnering with Yein Udaan, the centre provides after-school education for 50 children, offering tuition, counselling, and a nutritious meal from 4-8 pm, Monday to Saturday. It also empowers local women through vocational training in tailoring and computer skills. Additionally, health camps conducted by Dr. Avinash and Dr. Shivi have improved access to medical care for residents. The centre is a vital resource, fostering growth, learning, and well-being for the low-income community of Chennai.









The Interact Club was officially installed at Chennai High School, Kotturpuram, on August 1st. The ceremony, attended by students and faculty, featured Dr. Rajshree Vasudevan as the Chief Guest. The event emphasized youth leadership and the importance of nurturing essential values for the students' future growth.
