Next Gen Centre Inauguration

We proudly inaugurated the Next Gen Centre for Community Upliftment on December 10, 2024. This transformative initiative, supported by ASV Construction with an annual funding of ₹16 lakhs, provides a safe haven for children from Chetpet government schools. In partnership with NGO Yein Udaan, the centre offers after-school programs focused on life skills, tuition, and career development, ensuring holistic growth and support for underprivileged students.



The inauguration event was graced by distinguished guests, including the District Governor-elect, District Secretary, Rotarians, donors, Inner Wheel Club members, the Yein Udaan team, parents, and students. The overwhelming participation reflected the community's commitment to this noble cause.

In addition to educational programs, the centre emphasizes comprehensive community welfare. Weekly health camps, led by Rotary members, cater to local families, addressing essential healthcare needs. Vocational training for women and computer literacy classes are also being introduced, empowering individuals with skills for a better future.

This centre is a testament to Rotary's unwavering commitment to uplifting the underserved, fostering education, and enabling skill development. It embodies the vision of creating brighter opportunities for children and families, ensuring a lasting impact on the community.



Social Impact

A total of ₹72,000 was spent to purchase and donate 10 stainless steel wheelchairs to the Institute of Obstetrics and Gynaecology in Egmore. The hospital had been relying on outdated and worn-out wheelchairs that were difficult to maneuver and uncomfortable for patients. The Managing Director expressed sincere gratitude for the donation, as these new, sturdy wheelchairs will significantly improve the mobility and comfort of patients in need of assistance.



The donation also supports the hospital staff in providing better services by enabling smoother and more efficient transport within the facility. This contribution reflects RCM Next Gen's ongoing commitment to enhancing healthcare and making a meaningful impact on the community. It has been warmly received by the hospital, which has long been in need of updated equipment, ensuring better care for patients.



Since 2020, RCM Next Gen has adopted Thor, a 15-foot saltwater crocodile and the largest at the Crocodile Bank. Born in 1988, Thor is a majestic saltwater crocodile, known for his impressive size and age. He serves as a symbol of the importance of wildlife preservation.

Every year, Rotary Next Gen provides funds for his upkeep, ensuring his well-being and proper care. This initiative reflects the club's deep commitment to both wildlife conservation and community engagement, showcasing their dedication to making a positive impact on the environment.

Next Gen Centre Christmas Carnival



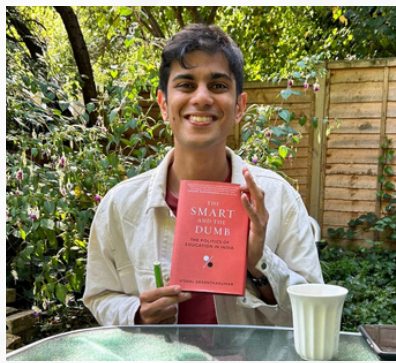

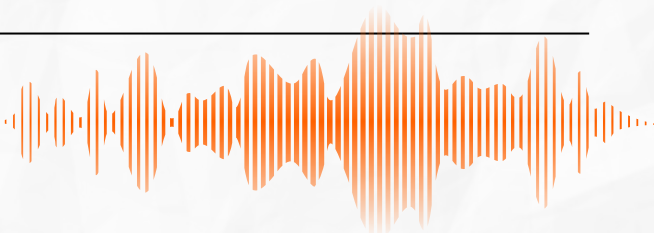
