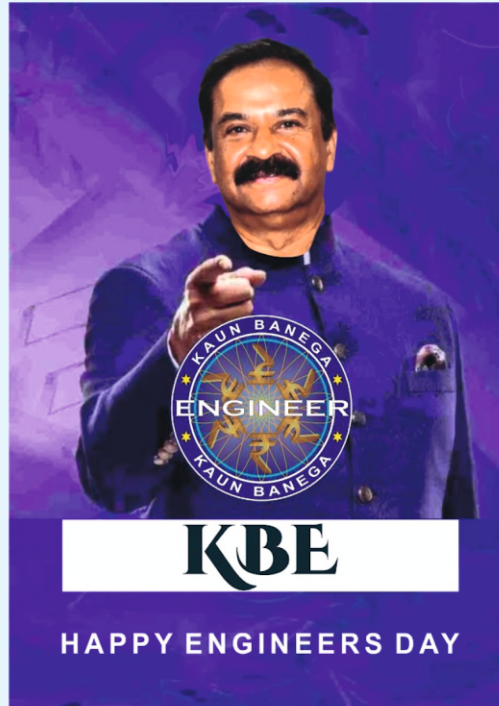

## Artha Shaastra to Vimana Shastra

**O**ur speaker, Retd. Group Captain Dr. Vinay Vittal, a distinguished and decorated officer of the Indian Air Force, spoke on the topic "Kautilya's Arthashastra and the Journey of a Fighter Pilot".

The first part of his speech was on the book Arthashastra by Kautilya or Chanakya. Vinay has studied this book in depth. This book was written over 2000 years ago. It is as relevant to domestic and foreign policy of governments today as it was so long ago. He mentioned the surprising fact that after the book was lost for many centuries, it was rediscovered in Mysore. He said that the main message of the book is how a ruler of a nation should take care of the welfare of his people. He also shared the unique and innovative Mandala theory propounded by this book. This theory explains the geo-politics that we see today making it a timeless book.

The second part of his speech described his journey as a fighter pilot. He described how the dream of becoming a fighter pilot started when his father took him to the Republic Day celebration and he saw the flypast of the India Air Force jets. He dedicated himself to this dream,

overcame many challenges and achieved his dream. He holds a world record for the most number of hours flown in the Jaguar. He shared a very important message to the



young Rotaractors - Have a Dream, Make it your Life's Purpose, Live your Dream, Dedicate yourself to your Dream and you will surely find success. He also shared challenging and life-threatening incidents in his fighter pilot career. Once, he was 300 miles away on the ocean when the avionics went dead. He was surrounded by

complete darkness but with calmness and courage, he brought the fighter jet back safely. This was another important message he shared: Life is full of challenges. If we stay calm, have courage and face the challenges with confidence, we can overcome them.

There was a lively Q&A session to end the speech. We thank Group Captain Dr. Vinay Vittal for his service to our nation and for an inspiring and thought-provoking speech which was full of hard-won life lessons and surely will immensely benefit all the audience members.

Since April 2008, I have embarked on a noteworthy journey within the police department, focusing on the training and development of respected officers. My tenure has included working with Gazetted Probationers such as Deputy Superintendents of Police, Police Sub Inspectors, Deputy Superintendents of Excise, Excise Inspectors, Regional Transport Officers, Karnataka Industrial Security force, (KSISF), Prison Officers, Probationary IPS officers, and officers from Pondicherry and the Maldives.

Throughout 17 years, my work has touched several esteemed institutions:

- Police Training School, Channapatna: I trained approximately 1100 constables during 2008-2009.
- Police Training School, Gulbarga: In 2011, I contributed to training around 145 Police Sub Inspectors.
- Karnataka Police Academy, Mysore: My involvement with this prestigious academy has been ongoing since 2008.

## THE ROTARY FOUNDATION: TURNING COMPASSION INTO ACTION

In 1917 Arch Klumph, President of Rotary International, proposed creating an endowment dedicated to “doing good in the world.” From that seed of vision grew what we know today as The Rotary Foundation (TRF), the heart of Rotary's humanitarian work across the globe.

**How It Works:** Think of the Rotary Foundation as a pool of kindness where contributions from Rotarians, clubs, and supporters worldwide come together. These funds are carefully invested, and the earnings are used to support life-changing projects. What makes TRF unique is its grant model:

District Grants fund local, small-scale projects close to home.

Global Grants support larger, sustainable initiatives that address Rotary's six areas of focus, such as clean water, maternal health, education, and peacebuilding.

Every contribution—whether large or small—goes through a cycle of stewardship. Money donated one year is

invested for three years, with the earnings helping cover operating expenses. After that, the principal amount flows back to districts and clubs as usable funds. This system ensures accountability, transparency, and sustainability.

**The Impact:** Through TRF, millions of children have been vaccinated against polio, communities have gained access to safe drinking water, women have received better maternal care, and students have been given the gift of education. Perhaps the most famous success story is PolioPlus, Rotary's global initiative that has brought the world to the brink of eradicating polio—a feat once thought impossible. These stories remind us that The

Rotary Foundation isn't just about money—it's about transforming lives with hope and dignity.

As Arch Klumph's vision promised more than a century ago, the Rotary Foundation continues to do “good in the world”—one project, one community, one life at a time.
