## RI PRESIDENT: ROTARY INDIA - HIGHEST SERVICE PROJECTS IN THE WORLD

In an interview published in the Rotary News India, RI President Rtn. Francesco Arezzo lauded Indian Rotarians. Rotary International consistently recognizes India for achieving the highest scale of service globally. A well-earned distinction, driven by its massive member base and the execution of high-impact projects.

The foundation of this success is Rotary's huge footprint: Today, India boasts over 174,000 Rotarians across more than 4,600 clubs, plus an additional 2,225 Rotaract clubs. This high volume of membership, energized by younger members, translates directly into an immense number of volunteer hours, magnifying Rotary's impact.



Furthermore, the Rotary Foundation in India (RF(I)) has championed large-scale projects, reflecting the country's big contributions. As of 2024, the RF(I) has supported over 3,375 projects with a cumulative value of approximately \$1.5 billion USD over the past decade. Landmark efforts include Rotary's pivotal role in India's certification as polio-free in 2014.

Financial strength is boosted by Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) partnerships, with RF(I) collaborating with nearly 500 companies. This commitment to ambitious service was recently highlighted by a \$2 million grant in 2025 for a water conservation program. As RI President Francesco Arezzo stated in 2025, the "quantum of service by Rotary in India is

the highest in the world."


