UDAAN : GIFTING WINGS TO UNDERPRIVILEGED STUDENTS

A project to give wings to underprivileged students by way of gifting brand new cycles was conceived and executed by our DG, Rtn Asha Venugopal on the day of her installation on 01st July 23.

In this, 5555 cycles are planned to be gifted to the needy students. This will not only benefit young under privileged students but also our environment. The Aim of this project is to reduce the carbon footprint, healthier India, lesser school dropouts.

In this project, different rotary clubs were to contribute 50% of the cost while the balance contributed by DG herself. It was very proud moment for our club when within just two days of appeal by our President, members donated more than ₹1L towards this worthy cause. Our club gifted cycles to students from tribal areas of Derapada, Pithundi, Ghubadsaka, Shejwalwadi and also NMC school at Anandvalli. In all 45 cycles were gifted by our club.

Cycles of Hero Bonfire 26T -Caliber Bike - Unisex make, costing ₹4000/- each were procured.

In the first phase 1000 cycles were gifted on 1st July 23 and balance are planned to be gifted during the current rotary year.

The smile on the faces of students said it all. This has spurred the club to do more in the future towards this project.



TREE PLANTATION

The first project of the July Month has to be “Tree Plantation”. It is also close to everyone’s heart.

We all enthusiastic Rotarian left for Belgaon Dhaga on the beautiful, clear and bright Sunday morning; 2nd of July. We were greeted and welcomed by a beautiful rainbow and clear bright sunshine, as if Mother Nature was blessing our entire team!

The project Tree plantation was very special as it was attended by our old as well as a number of new members. Our secretary projects Rtn Hemraj, environment director Rtn Pranav, community service director Rtn Unmesh implemented the project successfully in association with gram panchayat Belgaon Dhaga and forest department.

Hope our small efforts bring a smile on our Mother Nature’s Face.



Rotary Vatsalya Human Milk Bank : Civil Hospital, Nashik



Mother's milk is the most precious thing for the child. It just can not be replaced by any artificial combinations. It provides immunity from various diseases to the child. However there are many circumstances when the infant is deprived of this Amrut. In such situations the only correct alternative is to collect milk from lactating donor mothers and then give to needing infants. This is easier said than done. The donated milk has to pass many stringent tests before it can be used by a baby besides storing it in stringent conditions.

The first human milk bank was set up in Vienna, Austria in 1909, while in India it was set up in 1989.

Our club has the distinction of setting up the first such bank in Western Maharashtra in civil hospital, Nashik on 24th June 22.

This was indeed what could be called a watershed moment. Since then it has proven to be a boon for babies and their families too. Many lives were saved only because of the existence of this Rotary Vatsalya Human Milk Bank in civil hospital, Nashik.

In this milk bank, the average collection per day has topped 1200 ml and around 10 babies receive this Donor Human Milk every day.
