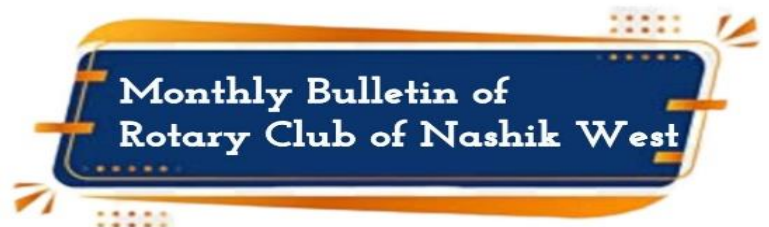

She was Rotary International Director in 2019-21. She holds a Doctorate in leadership studies from Indiana University of Pennsylvania. She is a Trainer/Educator/Facilitator/Consultant. Stephanie becomes the second woman to take office as President of Rotary International on 1 July 2024. Urchick will be succeeding Gordon R. McInally of Scotland who served as Rotary International's President in 2023-24. Stephanie A. Urchick has been associated with Rotary for 33 years, joining initially for fellowship but finding profound purpose in Rotary's service initiatives.
