EyeHope - Through our collaborative efforts, we successfully provided an Ophthalmic Operating Machine to Lokmanya Tilak Municipal Hospital, valued at Rs. 1.1 crore. This was made possible through a Global Grant and the past endowment fund established by the Barwale family, along with contributions from our Club. We extend our gratitude to the Barwale family and all members for their generous support in enhancing the vision of many underprivileged individuals visiting this hospital.

Little Heart - Little Heart project continues to shine as a beacon of hope for children suffering from congenital heart diseases. We have facilitated surgical interventions and post-operative care for 36 children, contributing Rs. 54 lakhs to the Sri Sathya Sai Sanjeevani Hospital in Kharghar. Our sincere gratitude goes to Rtn Gita Parikh of PPFAS, Mr. Sawant of Centaur Pharma, and Rtn Rohit Patel for their generous contributions. We also thank Rtn Anil Ambo and Rtn GS Kasbekar for their invaluable time and talent.

E-Learning - Our commitment to enhancing educational opportunities through the e-learning initiative has successfully bridged the gaps in access to quality education. By providing digital resources and training to students and educators in BMC Schools, we are empowering the next generation with essential skills for the modern world. Heartfelt thanks to Rtn Rajesh Sharma of Ion Exchange, Rtn Rohit Patel, and Rtn Gita Parikh for their support, as well as Rtn Ashwin Shah and his e-Learning team for their immense efforts.

ittle Hearts Project - It is a soul satisfying experience for our club to keep this as an ongoing project. Earlier we were subsidising the surgeries in a hospital where the patient's family had to contribute around 25% of the expense.

But then 3 years back the scenario changed. Our club tied up with Sri Sathya Sai Health and Education Trust, Navi Mumbai. This Trust has 3 hospitals and has added a fourth one in Hyderabad.

What is unique about this hospital is that here there is no Billing Counter. The patients and their families are treated with tender care and they dont have to pay a single rupee for the treatment snd stay at the hospital.

We are indeed indebted to PPFAS and Rtn Geeta







Parikh for sponsoring this project year after year on a big scale. We are also grateful to Centaur Pharma for their continued support to this project for the last 3 years. All this has been possible due to Rotary International providing us a simplified route of using Corporates' CSR funds for this noble project.

On 12 April 2025, like every year, President Jagar Thakur, Geeta Parikh, Shobha Sapat, Suruchi Chand, Anupam Chaturvedi, Nazneen, Anil Ambo, Deepak Mehta, Nazneen Jamsheed Patel, M. A. Parab and Anil Jadhav visited the hospital at Kharghar and handed over the cheques of Rs 55 lakhs.


