They say, if you give a child a fish, you feed him for a day...but if you teach him how to fish, you feed him and his family for a lifetime. This is the power of education and we at Rotary Club of Bombay Midtown are very satisfied with the formal launch of the E learning Project in 4 BMC schools in Mumbai which will impact the lives of over 4500 students year after year.

It is very gratifying to see a project reach fulfillment in its true sense with wholesome participation by all the stakeholders - the students, the teachers, the Education Department Seniors and culminating with the engagement of the highest authority, Additional Municipal Commissioner Dr Amit Saini.

Over a period of 5 months, 60 panels were installed in each and every classroom of the 4 selected schools. Training was imparted to all the teachers of the selected schools and only after 3 months of successful implementation and receipt of positive feedback from the teachers and Principals did the Committee feel confident to hold a formal launch.



The Project was inaugurated on 30 July 2024 at Colaba Municipal School by Addl Municipal Commissioner Dr Amit Saini who took time off from his busy schedule to participate in each and every deliberation of this event. Also present to bless the project were Mrs Aruna Sharma, wife of the Chairman and Ms Arpita Sharma of ION Foundation, who made a major contribution through their CSR Fund to this project.

Also present were Dy Municipal Commissioner Ms Chanda Jadhav, EO Ravi Tadvi. Dy EO Asha More, Area Officers, Principals, Arif Shaikh, Asma Batliwala, Vanita and others

The function was well attended by over 25 Rotarians and Rotary Anns, who promised their continued support to Phase 2 of the Project, where we plan to extend the program to 6 more BMC Schools.

Can You Hear the Whistle Blow, Time to listen to Gen Z

21 August 2024, Taj Mahal Hotel

At the start of her career, Dr. Indu Shahani, eminent educationist, former member of the UGC and former Sheriff of Mumbai, introspected on where she would like to go and what kind of change she would like to enable. A dynamic and inspirational personality, Dr Indu Shahani entertained us Rotarians with anecdotes and interesting tidbits which have dotted her illustrious career. Oftentimes humorous, sometimes educational and always inspiring, her talk is proof that determination, courage and hard work are the benchmark of a great leader.

Titled, 'Can You Hear the Whistle Blow, Time to Listen to Gen Z, Dr Shahani reminisced about her early days as an educator and how she constantly listens to and learns from the current younger generation of students known simply as Millennials or Gen Z.

Starting her teaching career at the tender age of 21 as a Masters student at Sydenham College, she was asked to teach and supervise a class of 18-year-olds. And while they were sometimes disruptive and amusing as teenagers tend to be, many are now leading lights of various industries in

India and include the late Rakesh Jhunjhunwala and Uday Kotak. As she took us down memory lane, we heard of the student who took an exam with a snake around his neck while a group of back benchers when chastised very sternly with, 'Last Bench Out!' literally carried their bench out of the classroom and merrily walked away!!

Shahani took over as the principle of HR College from her father in 2000 and cemented her sterling career as an educator. Leading from the front, she transformed HR into the leading Commerce College in Mumbai and India, spurring a growth in chartered accountancy, law and banking. Always encouraging and dynamic she steered her students and college towards excellence, independence and entrepreneurship.

Switching tracks to her current role as founding President and Chancellor of Atlas SkillTech University, housed at BKC Mumbai, she spoke about how she is inspired by the current crop of students who are known as Gen Z or Millennials. Describing them as problem solvers, they are guided by Digital Fluency, Social Consciousness and a strong sense of Individualism. At Atlas, a skill-based curriculum that encourages entrepreneurship, information technology, social responsibility and design has been instituted. Her students have responded to this innovative approach and are brimming with solutions. A case in point is a group of four female students who have developed a 'magic pen' called BRIDGE for blind persons. She reiterated that Indians all over the world are in key positions in the corporate and

tech world, and that this is largely due to educational opportunities. Her talk was followed by a vibrant Q&A session, and Dr Shahani received many compliments from our audience, acknowledging and validating her contribution to the world of education and entrepreneurship.

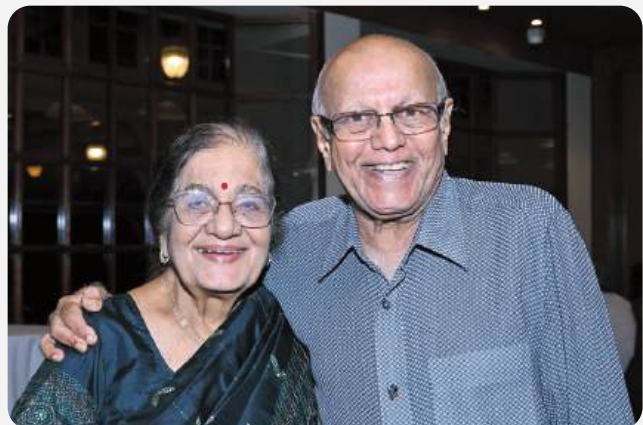

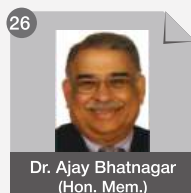


As he said once, “every time someone left, took a piece of my heart away” but I wish to tell him that “you took a piece of my heart but filled the place with a piece of yours”.....

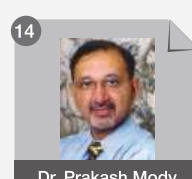
