
It is within your power to help make Rotary a beacon of goodwill and fellowship in every community. Remember that your work can and will change the world with The Magic of Rotary.

RI president Stephanie Urchick says it is the Rotarians that create the magic with every project completed with every dollar donated and every new member added.


Let us also think Big about giving to the foundation and growing our numbers at the end of the awesome year.

Club President Manish Patil's Brief Introduction





Mauritius Camps

Vitreo Retinal disorders can lead to loss of complete vision. Most common reason for this is Diabetes. Prolong Diabetes affects blood vessel in Retina leading the loss of vision. If not treated in time can result into loss of vision.

Rotary Club of thane in association with Rotary Club of Phoenix Mauritius has taken lead in this regard. Mauritius being tiny island country in Indian Ocean with population less than 1.5 million.



Govt of Mauritius has build advance infrastructure @ Subramani Bharati Eye Hospital Moka Mauritius. Local govt with help of other countries have developed good latest infrastructure. However they have limitations in

availability of skill in certain profession.

In consultation with Health Dept, Mauritius the need for having Vitreo Retinal expert was identified by Rotary Club of Phoenix Mauritius . They approached us requesting for help.

We promptly stepped in initiated the process & approached Dr Shweta & Dr Karan. Both Drs Promptly accepted our request & decided to join us for the camp.

During our visit on day one our Drs checked &



screened 90 patients with retinal dis orders. Some of cases were bad. From Tuesday till Friday 40 procedures were successfully done.

During the camp our Doctors got full support & cooperation from local team.

One of other objective was also to upskill the local team so they can perform the same alone. Local team could learn many things from our Drs.

Also they had formal training session/lecture for entire hospital doctors.
