

#### 8th July 2025 - Warkari Wari


President Girish and Secretary Kedar were on the stage. Girish deliberated on the ----- of installation ceremony.

#### 22nd July 2025

Rtn. Girish and Secretary Kedar were on the dias. Today's topic was unique and dear to our president, who was the speaker. He spoke on "Why and How of the

Pharmaceutical Dosage Forms". It was an audio-visual presentation.

To start with first lady Rhucha Vartak presented and read the interesting poem concerned with the topic.

It depicts the curiosity of a child who thinks how a medicine taken in the stomach relieves the leg pain



or headache or even stomach pain. The poem was a very well sung by Rhuchaji.

Girish was introduced by Secretary Kedar with his expert in pharmacology preparations and formulations.

He said medicines are available in different forms such as Liquids, Tablets, Capsules and injections. For each form the preparations are highly complex machinery and standardization and expertise of the Chemist.

He shared the different machines and other gadgets. The regulations and legal provision are many resulting in safety of the medicines. Capsule forms were introduced in 1833. The Blister form of packing has various advantages.

Question - Answer session was very interesting.
