Human Milk Bank

Meeting started with an invocation by Rtn. Mayur. With a brief introduction of the chief guest President Rtn. Archibald welcomed Dr. B Shantharam Baliga to our club's weekly meeting. Members celebrating their anniversaries and birthdays during the week were wished. Members were informed that the



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the annual district conference will be held virtually from 18 th and 20 th June 2021.

The chief guest of the evening was Dr. B Shantharam Baliga. He was introduced by Rtn. Dr. Narendra Kamath. He spoke on the topic 'Human Milk Bank'. He began his talk by sharing his experience on how the Neonatal ICU in Lady Goschen Hospital was setup. Dr. Baliga is helping our club in setting up the Global Grant Project of Human Milk Bank. With the help of slide show he explained the importance of Human Milk Bank. He also gave us details of the process involved in collection, pasteurisation, storage and how it will be delivered. This project is going to benefit over 500 new born babies and will save at least 80-90 lives every year. He explained the advantages of breast milk and said that if all the mothers who deliver breastfeed within one hour after birth 1 million babies can be saved across the globe. Human milk is therapeutic agent that protects term and preterm infants from both acute and chronic illness. This project after completion will cater to 8 surrounding districts for high risk deliveries and high standard of care will be offered. Vote of thanks was delivered by our President Rtn. Archibald and the meeting was adjourned for National Anthem.








Club Activity
