

Nigerian to become second African to lead

Olayinka Hakeem Babalola will serve as president of the global membership organization in 2026-27

As head of Rotary's 45,000 clubs worldwide, Babalola will lead Rotary's top priority of ending polio. Together with its Global Polio Eradication Initiative partners, Rotary has reduced polio cases by 99.9 percent and contributed more than US\$2.9 billion and countless volunteer hours to protect over 3 billion children from this paralyzing disease.

Rotary members throughout the world develop and implement sustainable, community-driven projects that fight disease, promote peace, provide clean water, support education, save mothers and children, grow local economies and protect the environment. More than US\$5.5







billion has been awarded through The Rotary Foundation – Rotary's charitable arm that helps clubs work together to perform meaningful, impactful service – to support these initiatives over the last 100 years.

About Olayinka Hakeem Babalola: Babalola holds a degree in engineering and spent more than 30 years in the oil and gas sector, including senior leadership roles at Shell PLC. He founded the Riviera Technical Services Ltd., an oil and gas infrastructure delivery firm, as well as Lead and Change Consulting, an executive coaching and organizational performance consultancy.

Babalola is a member of the Nigerian Society of Engineers, the Institute of Safety

Professionals, and the Association of Change Management Practitioners. He also belongs to the Jericho Business Club, a civic organization in Ibadan that contributes to national policy dialogue.

Babalola became involved with Rotary in 1984 through Rotaract — Rotary's program for young professionals and students — and joined the Rotary Club of Trans Amadi in 1994. He has since held a number of leadership roles within the organization and currently serves as a trustee of ShelterBox UK, Rotary's official project partner for disaster relief.

He and his wife, Preba, support The Rotary Foundation through a named endowment and are members of the Arch Klumph Society, which recognizes Rotary's highest level of philanthropic giving. His Rotary honors include the Africa Centennial Heroes Award, the Service Above Self Award, the Regional Service Award for a Polio-Free World, and The Rotary Foundation Citation for Meritorious Service.

India's Infrastructure Development: A Growing Story

India's infrastructure sector has been witnessing significant growth, driven by government initiatives and investments. The country's infrastructure spending has seen a substantial increase, with budget allocations rising to ₹10 lakh crore in 2023-24.

Key Initiatives

- PM Gati Shakti National Master Plan: Launched in 2021, this plan aims to integrate various ministries for coordinated infrastructure project execution, enhancing connectivity and reducing travel time.
- Bharatmala Pariyojana: This project focuses on developing about 26,000 km of economic corridors, aiming to boost logistics efficiency and freight traffic.
- Jal Jeevan Mission: Launched in 2019, the mission targets providing tap water supply to every rural household, with over 15.44 crore households covered as of February 2025.
- Smart Cities Mission. Aims at urban development with projects worth ₹1,64,706 crore, focusing on improving amenities and reducing pollution.

Recent Developments

- Metro Expansion: Delhi Metro logs highest-ever passenger footfall of 81 lakh in a day. PM Modi inaugurated new Kolkata metro routes and laid the foundation for a 6-lane elevated Kona Expressway.
- Highway Construction: National Highway construction pace rose 2.8 times from 12.1 km/day in 2014-15 to 33.8 km/day in 2023-24.
- Aviation Growth: India became the third-largest domestic aviation market, with operational airports increasing from 74 in 2014 to 157 by September 2024

Infrastructure Projects

- Mumbai's Urban Connectivity Upgrade: A \$100-billion infrastructure push is underway.
- I-95 Project: Ferrovial starts an \$825 million project in South Carolina and Georgia.
- O'Hare Airport Terminal D: A \$1.3 billion project breaks ground in Chicago.

Challenges and Opportunities

- Funding: Centre pushes banks to ramp up infrastructure lending amid slowing credit growth.
- Resilience: Concerns about infrastructure resilience highlighted by incidents like Heathrow Airport's closure.
- Sustainability: Focus on green infrastructure, like Shell Energy India's plan to expand Hazira LNG terminal capacity.
