The vibrant and inspiring National Library Week Celebration, held in collaboration with Shri Dharmendrasinhji Arts College from 14th to 20th November 2025, concluded on a truly remarkable note. With around 60–70 participants daily, the event brought together children and adults alike in a rich variety of literary and creative activities, reflecting the deep bond our community shares with RML's initiatives.

The entire conceptualisation of the seven days was done by the RML team (Pritiben Parmar & team). The event comprised of seven inspiring days during which we welcomed participants into:

- 1. Indoor Games (Day 1): The theme was 'Satta'-Ek Rajneeti ka khel.' Participants designed logos, crafted slogans, campaigned, and voted mimicking how a political sytem works—promoting creativity and civic thinking. Thus, on the eve of Children's Day, the children learnt a lot and enjoyed too.
- 2. Read-Aloud (Day 2): They read drama lines, poems, and passages, helping them improve their fluency, expression, and confidence.
- 3. JAM: Just a Minute (Day 3): With just one minute to think and one minute to speak on a given topic, students honed their spontaneous thinking and public speaking skills.
- 4. Caption Writing (Day 4): Inspired by heritage images from INTACH, participants created catchy captions (in up to ten words), which encouraged them to exercise brevity, creativity, and observation.
- 5. Book Review (Day 5): Each participant presented a 90-second review of their favorite book cultivating a critical appreciation for literature and public speaking.
- 6. Creative Writing (Day 6): Given topics, students spent 45 minutes writing, fostering imaginative expression as well as structure in their thoughts.
- 7. Debate (Day 7): Across various age groups, participants debated different topics strengthening their reasoning, persuasion, and collaborative learning.

ROTARY INTERNATIONAL NEWS

Contributions will support projects around the globe, including a robust recommitment to the fight to end polio By Etelka Lehoczky

Donors to The Rotary Foundation celebrated some big achievements in fundraising in the past year, showing their support for the wide array of programs the organization sponsors all over the world.

A multiyear campaign to increase the Endowment to US\$2.025 billion by 2025 exceeded its goal by US\$25 million. In 2024-25 alone, members and others contributed more than half a billion dollars to the Foundation.

"The goal was an inspiration, but the objective was to do good in the world," says Mark Daniel Maloney, the 2024-25 Rotary Foundation trustee chair. "We are making sure that Rotary will always be able to carry out that mission."

The Foundation raised more than US\$569 million in 2024-25 alone, exceeding its annual goal by almost US\$70 million. More than 478,000 individuals donated, along with over 31,000 Rotary clubs and nearly 1,900 Rotaract clubs.

Thanks to its donors, the Foundation was able to award 1,424 global grants, 468 district grants, and 74 disaster response grants in the past year. A US\$2 million Programs of Scale grant will help build peace and economic independence in Colombia. Rotary International also extended its long-standing partnership with the Gates Foundation, announcing a joint commitment of up to US\$450 million over three years to support global polio eradication efforts.

"Rotary members demonstrated their commitment to these efforts with their support of the 2.025 by 2025 campaign," Maloney says. In particular, he notes the large number of fundraising events around the world that Rotary's district governors organized.

"I am just amazed at the generosity of Rotary members," he says. "They came together to make it happen."
