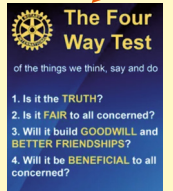

● **Project Overview:**

On a special occasion of the Official Club Visit of District Governor Shri Tusharbhaj Shah and Shu.shri Nehalben Shah, in collaboration with Rotaract Clubs of IPSA College, T.N.Rao College, and Christ College, set up three mini libraries in underprivileged areas of Rajkot. The project, titled "Gyan No Pataro," aims to promote literacy and education among children from disadvantaged backgrounds.

● **Objectives:**

- To provide access to quality educational resources for underprivileged children
- To promote literacy and education among children from disadvantaged backgrounds
- To foster partnerships with local community members, Rotaract Clubs, and educational institutions

● **Methodology:**

- Identification of underprivileged areas in Rajkot
- Collaboration with Rotaract Clubs of IPSA College, T.N.Rao College, and Christ College
- Collection of books, writing pads, and school bags from donors
- Setting up of mini libraries at identified locations
- Inauguration of mini libraries on 31st January 2025

● **Donors:**

● **Key Achievements:**

- Established three mini libraries in underprivileged areas, serving more than 400 children
- Provided access to quality educational resources, including books, writing pads, and school bags
- Promoted literacy and education among children from disadvantaged backgrounds
- Fostered partnerships with local community members, Rotaract Clubs, and educational institutions

● **Challenges:**

- Limited resources and funding
- Difficulty in identifying suitable locations for mini libraries
- Challenges in engaging and retaining volunteers

● **Future Plans:**

- To establish more mini libraries in underprivileged areas of Rajkot
- To expand the project to other districts of Gujarat
- To develop a sustainable model for the project
