Through his dedication and collaborative efforts, Dr. Khankari has played a pivotal role in securing and executing 10 Global Grant projects in partnership with our club and others in District 3142. These projects, totaling \$847,000, include six water-related grants worth \$515,000 that have improved access to clean and sustainable water, and four medical grants valued at \$342,000, addressing critical healthcare needs. His expertise and commitment have been instrumental in driving these transformative initiatives.
