Our club has actively participated with fellow Clubs in the Annapurna initiative by donating groceries to "Shri Swami Samarth Annachatra," which organizes daily meals for the needy.

The clubs together donated enough supplies to feed individuals for an entire week. This included essential items like rice, pulses, poha rawa, cooking oil, spices, and other staples necessary for preparing meals.

Target Beneficiaries:The primary recipients were homeless individuals struggling to meet their daily nutritional needs. Approximately 300 people benefit from daily meals at leading to an estimated 2,100 individuals impacted by the week-long support from the Annapurna project.

It demonstrated the club's commitment to making a tangible difference in the community and set a positive precedent for future initiatives.

The success of the Annapurna project today has likely motivated the club to continue and possibly expand such initiatives.
