



) Healing Little Heart

This year we are trying to do 33 Paediatric Heart Surgeries. There are three Hospitals working with us on subsidized rates i.e., Narayana Super Specialty, Howrah, RN Tagore Hospital Kolkata and Mission Hospital, Durgapur.

- On 22nd August, a heart surgery was done of 4 years old boy, Adil Ali Molla, at R N Tagore Hospital. His father is a daily labor having monthly income of Rs. 3000. They are residing in Kolkata. Medical Chair Mahinder Singhal and club secretary Ritu Choudhury visited the boy at Hospital on 25th August and wished the child a healthy life.
- On the same day another surgery was done of Master Saharsajit Das, 1 year 3 months old boy, at Narayana Super specialty Hospital, Howrah. They are residing in Howrah. His father is a machine operator having monthly income of Rs. 6000. On 25th August, PPAshok Agarwal, Amit Agarwal, Pradeep Agarwal and Shweta Choudhury visited the child at Narayana Hospital.
- On 31st August, a heart surgery was successfully done of a 7-year-old boy Amritaksha Das at R N Tagore Hospital. Team Mahanagar visited the child on 1st September comprising, Mahinder Singhal, Ritu Choudhury, Pradeep Agarwal, Uma Mohta, and Vinod Mahipal.
- On 5th September, Snigdha Mallick, 3 years old girl, from Nadia undergo ASD Device Closure at R N Tagore Hospital. Her father is a daily labor having monthly income is Rs. 3,000/-.



Eye Camp

On 22nd August 2023, an eye camp was held and 23 patients visited the Camp. 9 male and 11 female spectacles were advised and 3 patients were referred to our hospital for surgery.

On 4th September, we have started another vision center (Gocharan Vision Center). Hundreds of people will benefit by this center which will do basic eye checkup and provide specs. Those needing surgery will be sent to our Netralaya.


Members had a sumptuous Bengali lunch at the school! We were really motivated to improve the school and actively participated in this School Project.


