On 3rd March 2025, President Pramila visited RN Tagore Hospital to check on the little ones who had undergone surgery the previous Friday. The children were recovering well. On 4th March, MP Satabdi Roy, along with Rtn Sweta Chaudhary and Medical Director Girish Soni, visited baby Ishika Mondal at the hospital. Ishika, a one-year-old girl from Birbhum, required a BD Glenn surgery for her heart. Her father, a farmer with a monthly income of Rs. 5,000 (\$70), could not afford the surgery, which cost Rs. 3,65,000 (INR). The procedure was successfully conducted with the support of our Global Grant.

The camp provided essential eye care, with spectacles donated by Medical Director Girish Soni. The efforts of Chairman Jitendra Surana, President Pramila Dugar, and Club Secretary Sandeep Bagrecha ensured its success.

Netralaya



The Netralaya Eye Care Initiative successfully conducted 4 eye camps, screening a total of 564 patients. During these camps: • 74 cataract cases were identified.

218 free cataract surgeries were performed, restoring vision and improving lives.

short notice. Rotary Bloodline remains committed to saving lives through swift action and selfless service.




