






# Mind Marathon Quiz LAST RWM
























27th March: 24 patients

Between 20th March to 12th April 2025, the Rotary Club of Calcutta Mahanagar remained actively engaged in its Bloodline initiative, providing timely support to patients and promoting voluntary blood donation.

During this period, blood was arranged for ten patients, with donors stepping up across various locations and hospitals. Special recognition goes to Ms. Susmita Mondal, who donated AB Negative blood at Medical Bank, Kolkata, for patient Biswanath Barman from Purba Bardhaman, ensuring his life-saving surgery could take place.
