Adoption of Boynala Village - Pride of Rotary













The Rotary Club of Calcutta Mahanagar marked the first day of the new Rotary year, 1 July, with impactful service and community transformation as we formally adopted Boynala Village under the leadership of our new President, Rtn. Sanjay Bhalotia, Secretary, Rtn. Pradeep Agrawal and the Chief Guest DGE Rtn. Purnendu Roychoudhary.

Nestled in the South 24 Parganas district near Kolkata, Boynala is a tribal village rich in cultural heritage but still grappling with poverty and underdevelopment. The village faces challenges such as a lack of proper healthcare, limited access to quality education, unemployment, and poor infrastructure.

In a day filled with purpose and promise, several initiatives were inaugurated, laying the foundation for long-term development and empowerment in the village –

- Community Clinic: A step towards accessible healthcare for the villagers, ensuring basic medical support for both Allopathy and Homoeopathy.
- Vocational Centre: Launch of beauty and sewing courses to empower local women with skills and opportunities for self-reliance.
- Computer Training Centre: Bridging the digital divide by enabling youth to become tech-savvy and job-ready.
- Adult Literacy Program: As learning has no age limit, this initiative aims to educate and uplift those who missed
 out on formal education.
- GST: Promoting environmental consciousness through tree plantation and greenery drives.
- Annadaan Mahadaan: Serving fresh and nutritious food to 1000 beneficiaries- carrying forward our mission to fight hunger.
- Food Bank: 250 Cadbury chocolates and biscuits were distributed to children through the food bank initiative.

This milestone day stands as a testament to the dedication of the new leadership and the unwavering spirit of Rotary in serving humanity. It sets a powerful tone for the year ahead, promising meaningful change, one project at a time. A huge thank you to our 35 dedicated Rotarians attendees who made this project a success.

On 6th July, a Blood Grouping Camp was held at Metropolitan Charitable Trust, Metro Politan Durgabari, where 64 SOS donors were registered. The club also promptly met the blood needs of five patients through effective coordination. Further amplifying awareness, a Blood Grouping and Bloodline Awareness Drive was organized at Jesus Prayer House Church, Howrah, engaging the community and promoting the spirit of voluntary donation. The momentum continued with another Bloodline camp on 13th July at CST, Shreebhumi, Laketown, drawing active participation and commitment.

Homeopathy





RCCM continued its consistent community healthcare service through the Homeopathy Clinic initiative. On 10th, 12th, and 17th July 2025, three clinic sessions were held, directly benefiting 36 patients across these dates, with a total of 5 man-hours dedicated by volunteers. In addition, an Eye Camp was conducted at the clinic premises on 15th July 2025, where 30 patients were screened. Of them, 26 were prescribed spectacles (13 male and 13 female), and 4 cases were identified for further eye operations. This initiative reflects the club's sustained commitment to accessible healthcare for all.




