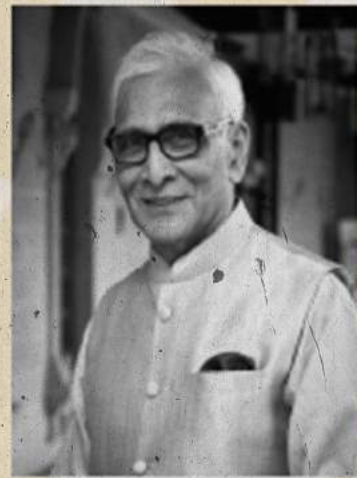

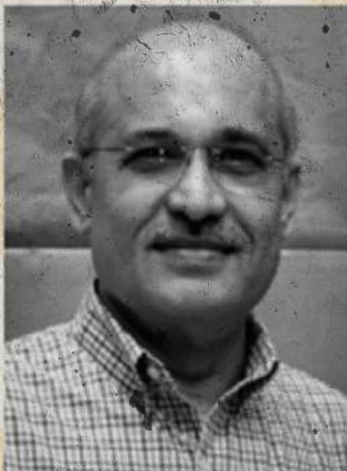

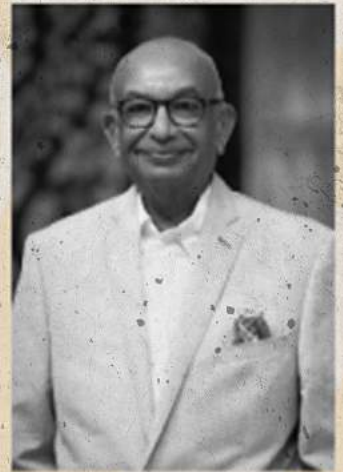

# Journey Through Time

*History is an elegant dance down memory's lane, an introspective journey where we retrace our origins, strengthening the foundation built by those who came before us as we move confidently into the future.*

*The Rotary Club of Bombay expanded its horizons by establishing the Rotary Club of Bombay North, carving a unique territory from Haji Ali in the south to Mahim in the north, spanning the western isle of Bombay, and extending from Lalbaug to Sion on the eastern frontier. Late R.I. Director Soli Pavri took the helm as Governor's Group Representative, spearheading this new endeavor.*

*On February 8th, 1962, at the National Sports Club, Rtn. Soli Pavri convened the first meeting of prospective Rotarians for the Provisional Club. Weekly dinners at the Sports Club followed.*

*The Club received its charter on August 29th, 1962, bearing the signature of R.I. President Nitish Laharry. The message was clear: "Kindle the Spark Within." District Governor Maddi Sudarsanam officially welcomed "The Rotary Club of Bombay North" into the Membership of Rotary International on September 24th, 1962, at 9:30 pm at NSCI.*

*Led by the first President, Rtn. Soli Pavri, and a dedicated board of directors, the Club began its journey with annual fees of Rs. 150 in February 1962, excluding dinner charges.*





*With 49 Charter Members and 21 added during the year, The Rotary Club of Bombay North has produced five District Governors and one R.I. Director: R.I. Director Soli Pavri, DG. Surendra Mehta, DG. Dr. Badar Maskati, DG. M.P. Apte, and DG. Vijay Jalan.*

*Over 62 years, the Club's service projects in Community, Vocational, and International Service have made a lasting impact. Distinguished guests like Hon. Shri Satya Sai Baba and Hon. Shri Swami Chinmayanandaji have graced its meetings.*

*The Rotary Club of Bombay North's journey is a testament to commitment and service, guided by the principles of Rotary International and the spirit of its founders. The achievements during the year are the usual criteria of the success of the Rotary Movement."*
