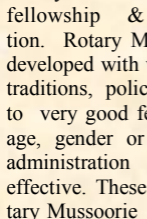

RI Strategic Plan

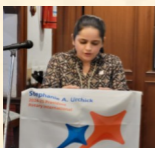

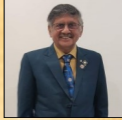

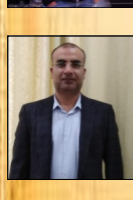
