VOCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP OF RS.25000/- TO RIYA

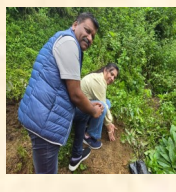

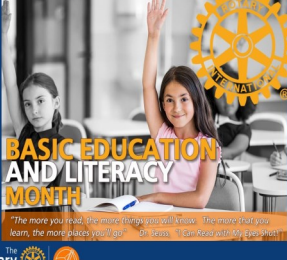
