## **Weekly Social Service Report by- Interact club of Mussoorie International School**

On **3rd August (Saturday) 2024** the Junior Interact Club members of Mussoorie International School, embarked on a social service project. This tour was intended to interact with the people living in Siya and Bira villages , raise awareness of important social concerns, and promote a sense of community and education.



### ***Nukkad Natak's Activities for Preserving a Female Child***

The students' potent Nukkad-Natak (street play) was intended to raise awareness of the value of rescuing and educating girls. The performance brought attention to the difficulties encountered by rural girls and the necessity of social change in order to empower and support them.

### ***Door-to-Door Promotion of Health and Sanitation***

To inform the villagers of the value of health and cleanliness, a group of students knocked on their doors. They talked about how easy it is to stay healthy and the advantages of keeping things tidy. The goal of the conversations was, to persuade the villagers to enhance their general health and well-being by implementing better sanitation practices.

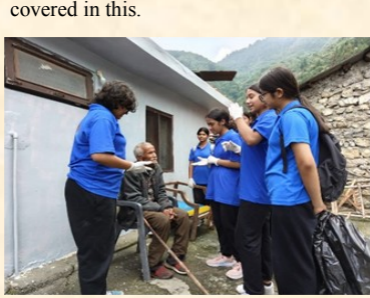


### ***Having Conversations with the Young and Elderly***

Several students made time to visit the young and old in the communities. The purpose of these exchanges was to foster a feeling of understanding and unity between the students and the locals. The students had happy times with the infants and their families as well as listened to the life experiences of the elderly.

### ***Gaining Knowledge of Livelihood and Encouraging Mindfulness***

The students interacted with the villagers to get knowledge about their way of life, customs, and difficulties. They also discussed the value of having an open mind and adopting contemporary lifestyles. Talks like gender equality, education, and the advantages of adopting new techniques and technology were all covered in this.



### ***Effect and Reaction***

The people of Siya and Bira welcomed the effort with open arms. Important discussions regarding the importance of gender equality and the significance of girl offspring were spurred by the Nukkad-Natak. Many villagers expressed their readiness to embrace better hygiene practices in response to the door-to-door educational campaign on sanitation and health. A connection and trust was formed through the student's interaction with the old and the infants. The community viewed the students' efforts to comprehend and explain modern methods favourably.

### ***Conclusion***

The weekly social service by Mussoorie International School's Interact Club was a significant step towards bridging the gap between urban and rural communities. It not only provided the students
