HELD ON 10TH SEPTEMBER, 2025



On 10th September, **Rotary Club Mussoorie** in collaboration with the **Mussoorie Sports and Cultural Association (MSCA)** and **Mussoorie Nagar Palika Parishad**, successfully organized the 21st edition of the annual “**Run for the Nation**”, a landmark event promoting fitness, patriotism, and community spirit.

This year’s event witnessed an enthusiastic participation of 374 runners, including 163 girls and 211 boys, representing **15 local schools and 2 clubs**.

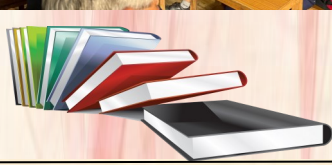
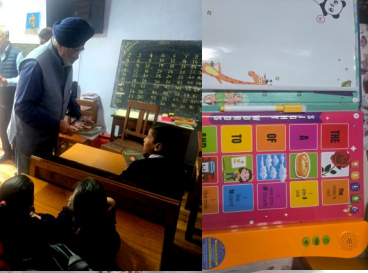
“DISTRIBUTION OF TEXT-BOOKS TO STUDENTS OF GOVT. PRIMARY SCHOOL, KULRI.”

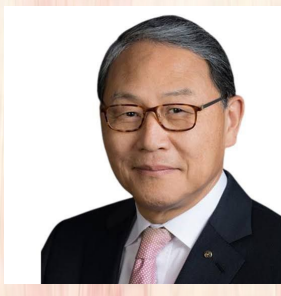

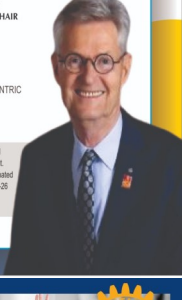
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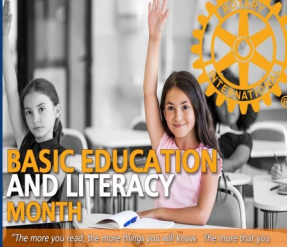
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
