2nd Tenure of Presidentship :

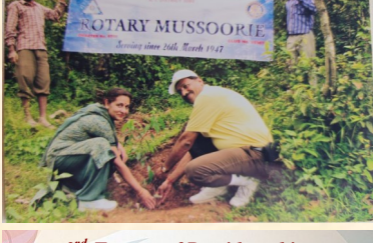
In his 2nd tenure as the **Club President**

- **Blood Donation Camp** was held for the 1st time & 135 units of blood was collected for IMA Blood Bank Dehradun.
